By participating in this Event, the riders are also agreeing to be bound by this technical guide, the instructions of the Commissaires and the Organization, and by the rules of the UCI.

## **ESPECIFIC RULES**

By participating in the competition, by signing up, the athlete agrees to:

I declare for all due purposes that I am aware of and in accordance with the regulations of this competition and exempt the organizers, sponsors, venue of the event from any and all consequences that may arise from my participation in this competition (theft, damage to equipment or for any trauma, injury, disability or death), NOT entitled to any type of indemnity other than insurance.

I further declare that I have never been prevented from participating in any other sport for medical reasons.

All registration filling information, where your category and personal data are included, are the sole responsibility of the participant.

The organization is not responsible for errors caused by incorrect or improper filling.

In an emergency, I authorize any qualified person to administer the necessary medical and/or surgical treatment, including the administration of blood.

I authorize that information regarding my health status is given by the responsible doctor to the race director as well as to my own doctor and/or my relatives or tutors.

The race may be video recorded and/or photographed; athletes who have any restrictions on the use of their image must do so in writing before the race. Otherwise, all images will be considered released for any type of use, on any date, without any financial compensation, indefinitely.

I AM AWARE THAT IN THIS TIME OF PANDEMIC THE RISK OF GETTING CORONAVIRUS 19 IS REAL. THEREFORE, I RELEASE THE ORGANIZATION FROM ANY DAMAGE TO MY HEALTH.



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It is the responsibility of each participant, staff and officials to have an international medical insurance (for assistance/financial coverage in the event of an accident).

The medical teams that support the event will only provide first aid and refer the injured person to the nearest hospital.

All hospital expenses will be paid by the injured person.

Athletes may only enter in the course, both for training and competition, with their number plate and helmet. Riders found training without this itens may be fined by the Commissaires' Panel.

For the event, the athlete must carry his number plate on the handlebars and his dorsal number on the back, at the height of the jersey pocket.

Plate numbers cannot be cut or altered.

Athletes who train outside the time established for their category may be penalized.

The athlete must start with the jersey of his/her Team-Club-Sponsor. It cannot be sleeveless.

If a raincoat is used, it must be transparent.

Only those carrying an identification, bracelet or badge will enter the feed/technical assistance area, which will be distributed when picking up kits.

Feed and technical assistance are only allowed in designated areas. Glasses exchanges must take place at the same location.

Contact between supporter and athlete will only be allowed in the supply/technical assistance zones.

It is not allowed to throw water on the athlete or the bicycle.

The manager must not run through the entire feed zone alongside the athlete to supply.

Food must be passed from hand to hand.

Bicycle exchange is not allowed.

Athletes who go out the course during the race for any reason must return to the course from the same point where they left off.

As soon as the timing company presents the final results of each category, it will be announced and posted.

An Appeal will be accepted during the race or up to 15 minutes after the result is announced.

After this period, the result will be approved by the Organization and published as official.

Only written appeal will be accepted.

The Appeals will be accepted up to 15 minutes after the final result of the category.

The event will be governed by this technical guide, the NF regulations and the UCI rules.

Cases not covered by this technical guide will be judged by the Commissaires' Panel. Their decisions will be final and no appeal against it will be accepted.
